### **DOPE ON SLEOPES:**

Minutes of September 30, 2009

In attendance: Shelly S., Steven A., A.J. S., Pam, Kimberly K., Jamie P., Tim, and Michele J.

Date(s) of Event: March 5, 6 and 7<sup>th</sup> 2010

Location: Brianhead, Utah

Discussion re Location of Event:

The committee discussed other locations to hold this year's event as Chalet Village is under new management and probable situations could occur should we choose again to hold the event at this location. It was agreed by attending DOS members to NOT hold the event this year at Chalet Village bases on these reasons.

Shelly S. brought to the table three (3) other alternative location options for discussion:

(1) Cedar Breaks Hotel – the hotel rooms consist of two (2) queen beds @ \$118.00 a night, and they also have Jr. Villas with kitchenettes available at an additional charge. The hotel can caterer Saturday night's event and the price of buffet meal would be approximately \$20.00 per person. The hotel is a spa, so NO OUTSIDE masseuse services will be permitted. The costs of massages are \$80.00 for 50 minutes at the hotel. The hotel accommodations include free use of their conference room area which is ample size for the event. The hotel has indoor/outdoor heated pool, Jacuzzi's and spa all included in the hotel. **However, the Conference Center is not available until the 2<sup>nd</sup> week in March, making the event on March 12, 13, and 14<sup>th</sup>.** Shelly S. has temporarily blocked 28 rooms for the event until a decision has been made by the Committee.

(2) Crystal Inn (Cedar City) – The Crystal Inn is located approximately 40 miles from Brianhead, Utah in Cedar City. The rooms are priced at \$69.00 a night, and they have ample conference room space to hold the event at no charge. The Inn has a catering service from the restaurant inside the Inn who would caterer Saturday's event for \$10-\$12.00 per person. Shelly S. is friends with them and has used them in the past. The Inn includes indoor/outdoor heated pools and Jacuzzis. The Inn DOES provide transport service to/from Brianhead 1x a day for attendees that lack transportation to Brianhead. Masseuses would have to be brought into the facility. The Inn is available for March 5, 6, and 7<sup>th</sup>. Shelly S. has also temporarily set aside rooms at this location.

(3) Rental Homes @ Brianhead – There are 2 large homes available for rent @ Brianhead, with (2) other possible homes as well across the street. The (1) one home is approximately 6000 square feet and sleeps several people (up to 20), with the other homes being comparable in size. The large home could be used for the Saturday night event which has an ample living area to

hold the event. The rental of the homes would be \$275.00 to \$375.00 per night, and include Jacuzzi spas. Outside masseuse's can be obtained and catering would have to be done thru members or brought in from a catering co. The homes are available March 5, 6 and 7<sup>th</sup>.

Resolution: The committee discussed the pros/cons of each location above, and after the discussion a vote was taken by the members for each location. The preferable locations are as follows: Option 3, Option 1, and Option 2. Shelly S. to check on availability of other rental homes and bring to next committee meeting.

Date(s) of Event: March 5, 6 and 7<sup>th</sup> 2010

Location: Brianhead, Utah

Discussion re Location of Event:

Shelly S. advised that the homes (Option 3) are not available as they are up for sale. Also, Chalet Village for sure will not be available due to new management.

Shelly S. spoke to Cedar Breaks lodge and the conference area is available March 12 – 14<sup>th</sup>.

There will be a charge to use the conference area on Friday night, however, they had not yet provided her a rate. The rooms are \$119.00 per night, and \$20.00 a person for the buffet on Saturday evening. As long as we purchase food from them the conference area is of no charge.

Merchandise was discussed consisting of t-shirts and beanies. Last year the registration was \$35.00 per person which included t-shirt/dinner and goodies. The Committee reviewed the expenses this year of holding event at Cedar Breaks and it was discussed that the t-shirt would be purchased separately since the costs of the registration will be higher than in years past. In reviewing costs it appears that the costs could be high (\$50.00)/ low (\$35.00) without t-shirts.

The committee reviewed (Option 2) regarding holding the event at the Crystal Inn in Cedar City. The costs and attendance was discussed and possible problems with transportation to the ski area. If this location was chosen the t-shirt could be included in the registration costs. The Committee discussed their concerns to hold event at this location and that it would be more affordable to the newcomer, then Cedar Breaks. However, a bigger concern was for driving to/from Brianhead from Cedar City. At this location we would be able to afford a separate room for a hospitality room, and provide refreshments.

The Committee took a vote as to location: Cedar Breaks lodge prevailed by 1 vote, however, the Committee agreed to table the decision on location until Shelly S. obtained the costs associated with using the Conference area on Friday night, March 12<sup>th</sup>. If the costs were too high, the committee may have to reconsider.

Flyer: Adam is to have draft of flyer done by next committee meeting and it's to be ready for distribution on November 1, 2009.

The Committee will meet again on October 28, 2009, at 6:00 p.m. at a location TBA.

Minutes of October 18, 2009

Date(s) of Event: March 12 – 14<sup>th</sup> 2010

Location: Brianhead, Utah

Discussion re Location of Event:

This was an impromptu meeting for DOS Committee held directly after the Regional Assembly. Shelly S. advised the Committee of the following regarding Cedar Breaks lodge. The costs for using the convention area on Friday night will be \$90.00, and an option of a 2 hour drink service if we choose for \$2.00 per person. If we hold 10-20 rooms the cost of each room is \$135.00 per night; if she has them hold 20-30 rooms the costs is \$127.00 per night. The room block deposit is due on or before December 17, 2009. Shelly proposed to only hold 10-20 rooms and deposit \$1350.00 with Cedar Breaks lodge. The committee agreed to avoid over booking the event. Also, Johan A. has agreed to sign the contract on behalf of NXNWA, and apply the tax exemption certificate to the hotel.

Location: A vote was taken by attending committee members, and it was agreed that the event this year will be held at **CEDAR BREAKS LODGE, BRIANHEAD, UT, March 12-14<sup>th</sup>, 2010.**

Buffett: Cedar Breaks has the following two (2) choices:

- 1) Salad, chili, corn bread, dessert & drinks - \$15.50 per person
- 2) Salad, pasta buffet, bread, dessert & drinks - \$21.00 per person

Based on the price of the buffet and the additional room charge on Friday, the Committee determined possible registration costs for this year's event with all of the above-considered would be as follows:

- 1) \$40.00 with t-shirt and choice (1) buffet
- 2) \$45.00 with t-shirt for choice (2) buffet

The committee reviewed these options and felt Option 2 Buffett and registration cost of \$45.00 with t-shirt would be acceptable. However, it was tabled again regarding merchandise to be sold separately instead of included in registration.

Committee agreed to table final decision regarding registration costs until the next committee meeting and choice of Saturday night buffet.
