Western States Zonal Forum (WSZF)/WSLD Western Service Learning Days

I attended WSLD on October 23-25 in Fresno as an experiment for the WSZF RDs and RDAs to gather and use this weekend as more of a learning tool and an opportunity to “train the trainer”. Many of our RDs and RDAs became speakers and presenters during the weekend and a lot of good information and resources were shared. I presented a workshop on activities which included an activity in the workshop.

I attended workshops during the day on Friday which included The Community Meeting and we performed a Mock Luncheon for the Community Meeting. The afternoon sessions contained Planning & Negotiation Events (in reference to conventions presented by Southern California). The afternoon ended with the “Message in NA Activities” that I presented. There were no Professional Personnel present from Drug Court.

On Friday evening, our formal WSZF meeting was held during the main speaker of which Terry H. of Southern Nevada was the Friday night speaker. Of 12 Regions in our forum, we had 12 of our RDs and RDAs present and one on a conference call. We discussed the benefits of permanently changing the forum meeting to coincide with WSLD and all Regions present were in favor of it. The regions liked the

fact that there was more NAWS participation and more hands on learning because there were materials provided. We discussed the agenda for our next forum meeting in late January which will cover the Conference Agenda Report (CAR) and the Conference Approval Track (CAT).

Other items that were discussed was any new hot topics of which were breakdown of communication in certain regions and what, if any workshops are being held on any of the issue discussion topics. Many regions are taking the show on the road and traveling to local areas to do these workshops. There is a wide array of present and past topics that regions are still using. There was also a brief discussion about the 2010 Delegate survey and what the delegates wanted to be part of the agenda for the WSC (World Service Conference). Discussion topics included WSC Seating, PR projects, and the Service System.

The late night Friday session was on The Message, The Internet and Social Media Tools which was invaluable. We talked about Facebook, My Space, Google Groups, Yahoo Groups, Twitter, etc. We discussed how documents should be password protected as to protect the anonymity of the author writing reports.

Saturday was a jammed pack day. There were 4 tracks which meant there were 4 different workshops going on at the same time. There were 2 funded representatives from Southern Nevada and myself from the region that attended. There were other members present of whom our hope is that they are implementing the information they heard and applying the tools in their area. The 4 tracks included the NAWS track, the Public Information Track, the Hospitals and Institutions Track and the NA Service Academy. I jumped around a bit and attended 5 workshops which included Core Principals of PR, Living Clean Literature Workshop, Supporting Each Other-Funding our Service, APT "Lighting the Fire", and Building a New NA Service Structure.

After the Sunday morning speaker meeting, most of the zonal members present attended the WSLD business meeting. There were no bids for next year so it is up in the air of whether they will have it or not. In 2011, Bend, Oregon won the bid. We had a discussion of whether the WSLD committee enjoyed the participation from all the RDs and RDAs present and if they would continue to make arrangements for us to hold our meetings. Bend, Oregon couldn't wait to see us again! Most areas and regions really felt they were getting more "bang for their buck" with the cost of travel expenses vs. information they are receiving back from their RDs and RDAs.

Conference Agenda Report (CAR)

Ira and I are setting appointments up to visit each area service during the month of February to inform the GSRs of what is in the CAR to be prepared for our March, 2010 assembly on Sunday, March 21, 2010. North by Northwest has already penciled us in. The *Conference Agenda Report* has been available since November 25th (translated versions available on 25 December). The CAR will cost \$8.00, which includes shipping and handling. It will also be available online at www.na.org/conference with the user name and password WSC 2010. Part of the CAR will be the new proposed "In Times of Illness" pamphlet.

We also just got word in November that the Alaska Region has joined our Western States Zonal Forum. They are hoping to attend our forum meeting in January in San Diego and they are asking any regions that may be able to help supplement their trip as the airfare alone is \$500.

I will try to have their information added to the website and the rest of the website brought current before our next meeting on the 5th.

I would like to congratulate Paul H as our new chair. I missed that meeting and I know there is unfinished business as far as the webmaster position. I am willing to stay on for another year if you would like me to. This would allow me to implement some new changes and finish what I started. If, you would like to move in another direction I will help whoever is slated to move into the position.
